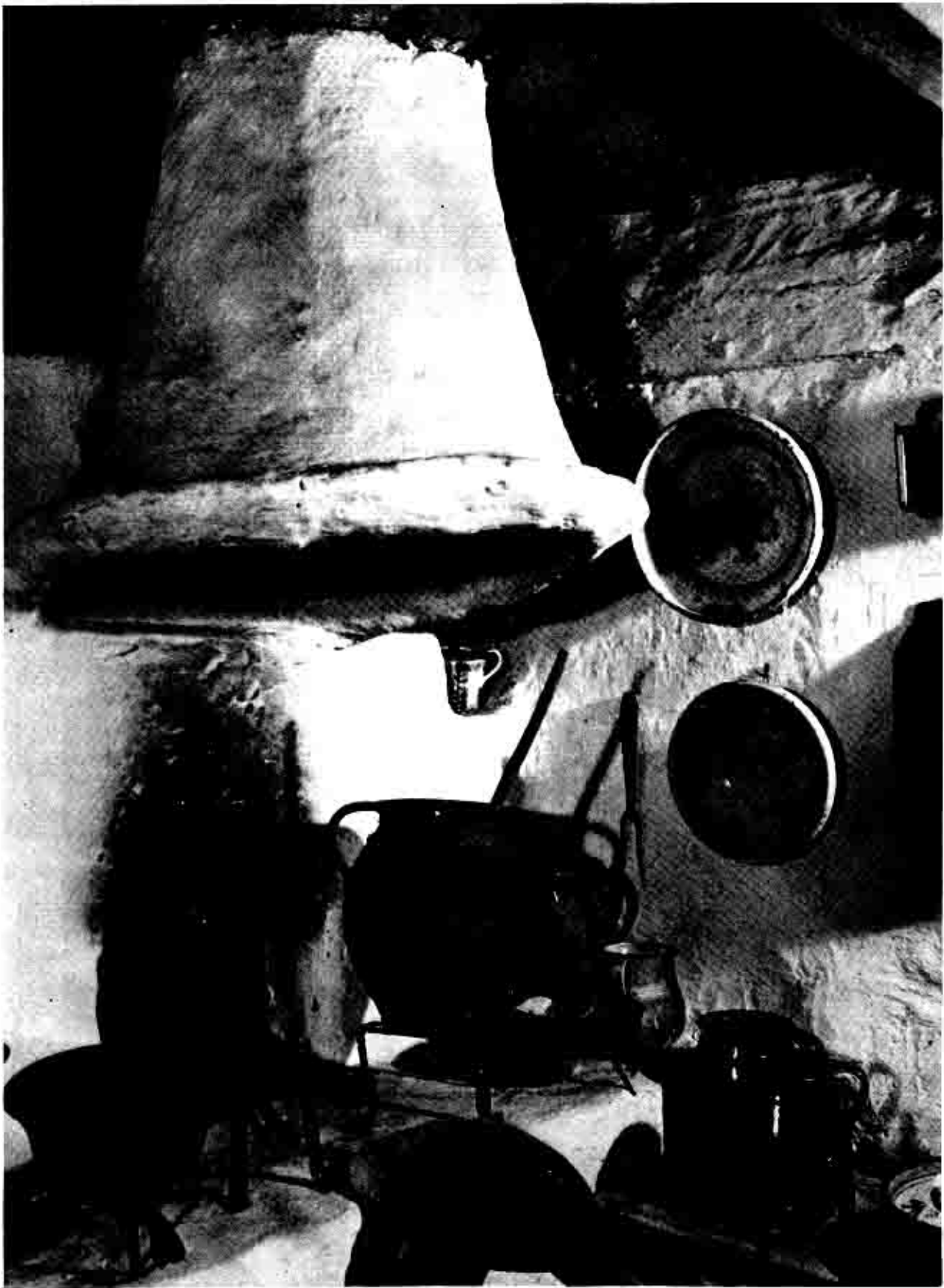


## PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA
